NB: These fees are set to no more than cover club fixed operating costs – i.e. for an Ordinary Member 60% goes towards club insurance and 40% to the cost of club affiliation with Yachting WA & Silver Membership of the individual.

New membership subscriptions attract a discount based upon the time of nomination acceptance. This applies to the annual subscription only. The sailing year commences on 1st April.

Visiting Reciprocal members must be financial ordinary or life members of another Western Australian club, which is affiliated with Yachting WA.

Ordinary Membership provides the member with Silver Membership status with Yachting Australia and provides members with competition status for all club, association, State, National and International events. Silver membership with yachting Australia provides insurance cover of \$75,000 injury, \$75,000 death, door to door on any YA business or activity.

* Family membership consists of 2 Adult Silver sailing members and all children under 18 and over 5 years of age.

** Temporary membership can only be obtained for a maximum of three races, after which such persons must become a full member.
